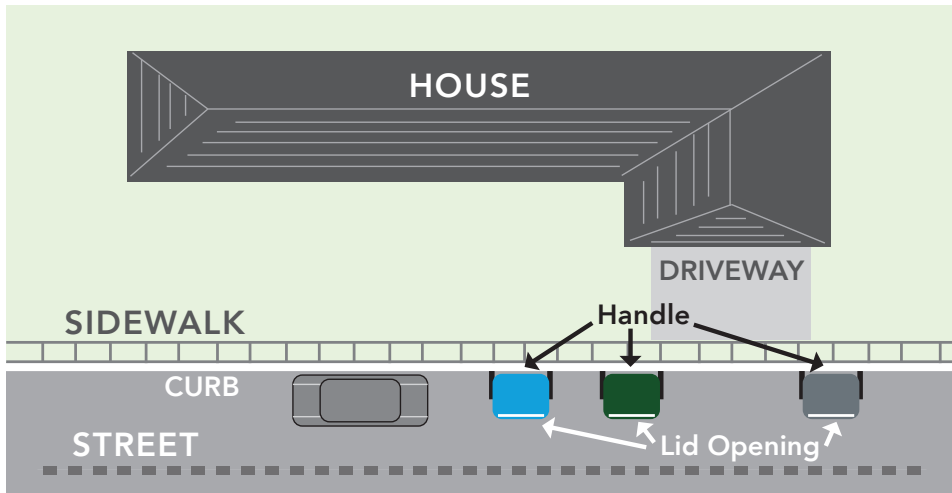




# ZERO-IN DIXON

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be no change in the collection schedule for Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 23. Residential waste collections will be made as usual. The Recology Hay Road Landfill will be open.

Christmas and New Year's Day fall on Monday this year. There will be no collection on these holidays. All collections will take place one day later than regularly scheduled. Friday collections will take place on Saturday.

The Recology office in Vacaville and the Recology Recycling Facilities will all be closed on Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. Contact Recology Hay Road Landfill for their hours.

## CHECK FOR PROPER CART PLACEMENT

- Carts should be placed in the street with the wheels touching the curb.
- The lid should open to the street with the handle in the back.
- Don't block the sidewalk.
- Don't park cars within three feet of carts.
- Place carts three feet apart.
- Put carts out by 6 AM on your pickup day.
- Remove carts from the curb as soon as possible after pickup and place them out of view from the street.

### WHY COMPOSTING MATTERS

CalRecycle estimates that **more than 40%** of the waste disposed in landfills could have been composted instead.

Keeping food and other compostable materials out of landfills is one of the easiest actions you can take to reduce your carbon footprint!

In Dixon, residents can place food scraps, food soiled uncoated paper and yard trimmings in their green carts for collection. Once collected, these items are transported to our compost facility where we grind the material and place it in piles known as windrows. We add heat and water to the piles, screen out materials that shouldn't have entered the facility in the first place (such as plastics that won't compost) and end up with a nutrient-rich soil amendment used by farmers and landscapers.

### KITCHEN COMPOST COLLECTION CONTAINERS AVAILABLE

Dixon residential customers can pick up a free organic waste kitchen pail from the Dixon Recycle Center at 302 N. 1st Street, Dixon.

Kitchen pails provide easy collection and disposal of kitchen scraps into the organics bin. These containers have a lid to help reduce odors and are dishwasher safe. Compostable bags are not allowed in your green cart.



### LAST CALL FOR COMPOST

Hurry to load up on compost at no charge. This offer is for Dixon residents who reside in the city limits. Show your Recology bill or other identification at the Recology Hay Road scalehouse.

Compost will only be available until October 31, weather permitting. Customers are entitled to three yards per visit, one visit per day. Supply is limited and subject to supply on hand. Bring a shovel to load up your vehicle, and bring a tarp to cover your load of compost. Your ID will be checked for proof of residency.

### KEEP BIKE LANES OPEN

Did you know placing a trash can in a bike lane is a violation of the California Vehicle Code (CVC)?



Carts set in bike lanes block routes and force cyclists into vehicle traffic, and are particularly problematic at night as garbage bins are difficult to see.



### SPECIAL PICKUP SERVICE

Do you have extra trash or large items that will not fit in your gray bin? Recology is here to help!

Call us at least one work day in advance to schedule these services so we can guarantee pickup, call 707.678.4026. We will give you an estimate of charges and answer and questions about this service.

### PUT LEAVES IN THEIR PLACE

Only water should go in the storm drain system. Please refrain from raking leaves into the street and properly contain leaves for recycling or debris for disposal.

Homeowners must make sure that commercial gardeners do not rake or blow leaves into the street. For more information call 707.678.4026.
